## FAQ REGARDING "COMPASS DRAW" FORMAT

What exactly is a "compass draw"?

A compass draw is a draw format that allows all players to play 4 rounds. It is called a compass draw because it resembles the 8 points of a compass (North, South, North-East, etc.). All players start in the middle. Winners of the first round move East, losers West. Losers in the East in round 2 move North. Losers in the West in round 2 move South. The effects of this type of draw is that players of similar skill levels tend to gravitate to the same portions of the compass. This helps to keep matches competitive. Please understand the point of this tournament is to have fun, engage in social competition, and raise money for LowCountry Habitat!

### EXAMPLE OF COMPASS DRAW
